To encourage promising graduate students to pursue crystallography-oriented research, the International Centre for Diffraction Data (ICDD) has established the Ludo Frevel Crystallography Scholarship Fund. Multiple recipients are selected on a competitive basis, each receiving an

award of \$2,500. Applications must be received by the ICDD by 29 October 2010.

Qualifications for the applicant: The applicant should be enrolled in a graduate degree program during the 2011 calendar year with major interest in crystallography, e.g. crystal structure analysis, crystal morphology, modulated structures, correlation of atomic structure with physical properties, systematic classification of crystal structures, phase identification and materials characterization. The term of the scholarship is one year. In order to broaden the geographic distribution of the scholarships, the committee will give special consideration to applicants in regions underrepresented in the past. These include Turkey, Africa & Middle Asia, China, India and Southeast Asia (Indonesia), Newly Independent States, and Latin

America. We encourage applicants from all regions to apply.
